

The **Coeymans Creek Wildlife Management Area (WMA)** is a 360-acre public conservation site in southern Albany County. It features over 7,100 feet of frontage along Coeymans Creek, a designated trout-spawning stream. The landscape consists of flat forested wetlands and deep ravines, providing vital habitat for local wildlife. Popular for hunting and wildlife viewing, it offers a tranquil escape near the state capital with easy access from Route 144.
