

The **Hoffman Notch Trail** is a 7.4-mile trek through the remote Hoffman Notch Wilderness in the Adirondacks. It traverses a scenic valley between Hoffman and Blue Ridge Mountains, featuring dense forests, wetlands, and the picturesque Big Marsh. This relatively flat path follows Hoffman Notch Brook, offering a peaceful experience with minimal elevation gain. Popular for hiking and winter cross-country skiing, it requires a car shuttle if completed as a point-to-point trip between its north and south trailheads.
