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The miller controlled the movement of the mill by turning a wheel which raised or lowered the runner stone. The higher the runner, the coarser the meal.

Millstones
The round, wooden cases on the plate-form each contain a pair of millstones. The stones are made of a hard, heavy material and are shaped to grind grain into meal. The miller controls the pressure between the stones by turning a wheel on the right-hand side of the mill. Millstone produced a white, original meal.

A portion of the mill is shown in the illustration. The millstone is a large, round, flat stone. The miller controls the pressure between the stones by turning a wheel on the right-hand side of the mill. Millstone produced a white, original meal.
