



The 538-acre Chautauqua Gorge State Forest provides opportunities for informal outdoor recreation such as snowmobiling, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, hiking and hunting. This state forest also offers a day use area with picnic tables and fire rings, out house facilities, and a public parking area.

There are 8 designated camp sites on Hannum Road adjacent to the day use area. Seven of the sites are primitive tent sites with a rock fire ring. Site #8 is upgraded with a picnic shelter and steel fire ring as well as a gravel parking pad large enough for a small self-contained camper unit. The sites are designated with a yellow camp disk. All camp sites are first come, first serve.
