

Located in Oneida County, Webster Hill State Forest spans 926 acres of tranquil, rolling woodlands. It features steep terrain, scenic views, a small pond, and deep ravines carved by Chase Creek. The forest is a mix of natural hardwoods and diverse evergreen plantations.
